The Board of Canvassers met at 2:00 o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, November 12, 1996, in Room No. 103 of the Monongalia County Courthouse and began by receiving sixty-four (64) Absentee Ballots, and fourteen (14) Challenged Absentee Ballots, from Cheryl Kisner and Joan DeChristopher of the Circuit Clerk's Office. Said ballots were received too late to be delivered to the polls. Eight (8) Spoiled Ballots were received from said Office; and two (2) Absentee Ballots, which were sealed but marked "Spoiled", were also received. The verification of said Absentee Ballots will be forthcoming.

At 2:15 o'clock PM, the Challenged Ballots were removed from the Locked Ballot Room and transported to Room No. 103 to make a matter of record the number of said ballots received from the individual precincts.

In accordance with West Virginia State Code 3-4A-28(4), the Board of Canvassers proceeded to choose at least five percent (5%), being four (4) of the precincts, at random by the drawing of precinct numbers, and then proceeded to manually count the ballots of those Precincts. The following Precincts were selected:

Precinct 56
Precinct 85
Precinct 76
Precinct 6

The Board of Canvassers accepted one (1) Absentee Ballot from Precinct 81, which was delivered to Precinct 8, as received from the returned election supplies.

The Board of Canvassers accepted one (1) Absentee Ballot from Precinct 24, which was delivered to Precinct 8, as received with the returned election supplies.

Voter Timothy Wolfe erroneously received two (2) Absentee Ballots from the Circuit Clerk's Office and graciously returned one (1) unmarked Absentee Ballot.

One (1) Absentee Ballot from Precinct 87 was questioned. The name on the envelop did not match the name on the application. Said question was referred to the Circuit Clerk's Office. The application was mistakenly placed on the wrong envelope by the Circuit Clerk's Office. The Board of Canvassers accepted said Absentee Ballot.

The Board of Canvassers accepted three (3) Absentee Ballots from Precinct 37, which were sent to the wrong precinct by the Circuit Clerk's Office.

A motion was duly made by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to refer the five hundred ninety-five (595) Challenged Ballots, and the seventy-two (72) Absentee Ballots, which included the two (2) Absentee Ballots marked "Spoiled", to the County Clerk's Deputies for preparation of a synopsis.

Prior to the recessing of the Board of Canvassers, the Challenged and Absentee Ballots were transported back to the Locked Ballot Room of the Monongalia County Courthouse.

A motion was duly made by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles to reconvene the Board of Canvassers on Wednesday, November 13, 1996 at 1:00 o'clock p.m. to begin the hand tallying process of Precincts 56, 85, 76, and 6, which will verify the accuracy of the Optical Scanners.

A motion was duly made by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to recess the Board of Canvassers at 3:10 o'clock p.m. until Wednesday, November 13, 1996 at 1:00 o'clock p.m.

The four (4) hand tallying teams proceeded with the manual counting.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 3:05 o'clock p.m. for a brief break.

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 3:13 o'clock p.m. to continue with the manual counting process of the four (4) precincts randomly selected.

Precinct 56 Hand Tallying Team completed their manual counting at 3:40 o'clock p.m. The votes were then tallied and each verified to the Summary Report generated by the Optical Scanner, which displays the numbers of ballots cast. There were no discrepancies found. The ballots and the Tally Books were placed back into the ballot box and secured.

Precinct 76 Hand Tallying Team completed their manual counting at 4:40 o'clock p.m.

Prior to the recessing of the Board of Canvassers, the ballots, and Tally Books from Precincts 76, 6, and 85 were placed back into their designated ballot boxes, secured and transported back

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 1:00 o'clock p.m., on Thursday, November 14, 1996, in Room No. 103 of the Monongalia County Courthouse. Monongalia County Commission President Betty L. Wiley was not present at this time.

Precincts 85, 76, and 6 Ballot Boxes were removed from the Locked Ballot Room and transported to Room No. 103 of the Monongalia County Courthouse.

The County Clerk's Deputies completed the preparation of the Challenged and Absentee Ballots for synopsis.

Precinct 76 Hand Tallying Team, which included Commissioner John Pyles, Deputy Clerk Cathy Palmer, and Deputy Clerk Deborah McGinnis, proceeded to tally and verify the manually counted votes to the Summary Report generated by the Optical Scanner, which displays the numbers of ballots cast. Several discrepancies were revealed between the manually counted Tally Books and the Summary Report.

When there was a discrepancy in the number of votes that a candidate received between the manually counted Tally Books and the Summary Report, the votes for said candidate were manually double checked.

At the conclusion of this process, there were three (3) discrepancies revealed.

Two (2) discrepancies were the result of the Optical Scanner counting a vote, which should not have been counted. Said vote was covered improperly by a label. Those discrepancies are as follows:

The ballots and the Tally Books were placed back into the ballot box and secured.

The Hand Tallying Team for Precinct 85, which included Deputy Clerk Tonya Rowan, Deputy Clerk Ruth Riffle, and Tally Clerk Ruth Overfield and the Hand Tallying Team for Precinct 6, which included Commissioner Florence L. Merow, Deputy Clerk Betty Tennant, and Tally Clerk Iona Rose, proceeded to continue with their manual counting.

Precinct 85 Hand Tallying Team completed their manual counting at 2:08 o'clock p.m. The votes were then tallied and each verified to the Summary Report generated by the Optical Scanner. Several discrepancies were revealed between the manually counted Tally Books and the Summary Report. After double checking manually the candidate's votes, there was one (1) discrepancy revealed as a result of the voter incorrectly marking the ballot. This discrepancy was as follows:

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 10:00 o'clock a.m., on Friday, November 15, 1996, in Room No. 103 of the Monongalia County Courthouse.

The Challenged and Absentee Ballots were removed from the Locked Ballot Room and transported to Room No. 103 of the Monongalia County Courthouse.

The Board of Canvassers proceeded to review the eighty-seven (87) Absentee Ballots, which included sixty-five (65) ballots received from the Circuit Clerk's Office, fourteen (14) Challenged Absentee Ballots received from the Circuit Clerk's Office, six (6) Absentee Ballots received from returned election supplies, and two (2) Absentee Ballots marked "Spoiled".

Three (3) regular Absentee Ballots were disallowed because the voters voted at their precinct on election day.

A motion was duly made by Commissioner Pyles, seconded by Commissioner Merow, and unanimously carried, to disallow two (2) Challenged Absentee Ballots because one (1) voter was not registered and one (1) ballot was mailed too late for the election.

Therefore, the total allowed Absentee Ballots were eighty-two (82); thereafter the Canvassing Board proceeded to remove the Absentee Ballots from their respective envelopes, and to separate the ballot stubs from the ballots to prepare them for tabulation.

Commission President Betty L. Wiley authorized the County Clerk's Deputies to proceed with the comparison of poll tickets of each precinct to the Statements of Ballots Used as well as the Summary Report generated by the Optical Scanner displaying numbers of ballots cast.

During the process of reviewing the Challenged Ballots, and at the conclusion of the comparison of poll tickets to the Statements of Ballots Used for each precinct, the ballots were then sealed into envelopes identified by precinct number with the Commissioners signatures across the seal of said envelop. Said envelopes were returned to the Locked Ballot Room.

At 11:00 o'clock a.m., the Board of Canvassers proceeded to review Challenged Ballots for allowing or disallowing as permitted by law.

Advice was sought and received from the Secretary of State's Office of whether or not ballots belonging to individuals voting in the wrong precinct could be counted. The advice received from said Office was that if said ballots were counted, that this procedure would be against West Virginia State Code.

Precinct No. 92 - Eight (8) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow five (5) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 1 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: Two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 2 - Four (4) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters voted absentee and also voted in person.

Precinct No. 3 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow the five (5) ballots.

Precinct No. 4 - Ten (10) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow eight (8) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter was not registered; and one (1) voter voted absentee and also voted in person.

Precinct No. 5 - Eleven (11) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow nine (9) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 6 - Six (6) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 7 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 8 - Nine (9) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow seven (7) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 9 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter was not registered; and one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 10 - Seven (7) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow five (5) ballots for the following reasons: three (3) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 12 - Twelve (12) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow ten (10) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 13 - Thirteen (13) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow five (5) ballots and disallow eight (8) ballots for the following reasons: five (5) voters were not registered; and three (3) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 14 - Seven (7) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 15 - Fifteen (15) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow twelve (12) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: One (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 12:20 o'clock p.m. for a brief break.

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 12:40 o'clock p.m. to continue to review the Challenged Ballots for allowing or disallowing as permitted by law.

Precinct No. 16 - Two (2) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the two (2) ballots.

Precinct No. 17 - Fifteen (15) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow twelve (12) ballots for the following reasons: ten (10) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 18 - Twenty-Two (22) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow twelve (12) ballots and disallow ten (10) ballots for the following reasons: eight (8) voters were not registered; and two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 20 - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow one (1) ballot and disallow two (2) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 21 - Eighteen (18) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow six (6) ballots and disallow twelve (12) ballots for the following reasons: four (4) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and eight (8) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 22 - Eight (8) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow (4) ballots for the following reasons: two (2) voters were not registered; and two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 23 - Six (6) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 24 - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow one (1) ballot because the voter voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 25 - Four (4) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the four (4) ballots.

Precinct No. 26 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow one (1) ballot because the voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 28 - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow one (1) ballot and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 29 - Eight (8) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the eight (8) ballots.

Precinct No. 30 - Six (6) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots because the voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 44 - Sixteen (16) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow twelve (12) ballots and disallow four (4) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and three (3) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 46 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 60 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow one (1) ballot because the voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 61 - Nineteen (19) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow ten (10) ballots and disallow nine (9) ballots for the following reasons: four (4) voters were not registered; and five (5) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 62 - Seven (7) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow four (4) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and three (3) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 63 - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow one (1) ballot because the voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 67 - Eight (8) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow four (4) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 68 - Four (4) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter was not registered; and one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 74 - Four (4) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the four (4) ballots.

Precinct No. 75 - One (1) Challenged Ballot - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the one (1) ballot.

Precinct No. 76 - Eight (8) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow six (6) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct No. 77A - Six (6) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 77B - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow the three (3) ballots.

Precinct No. 78 - Ten (10) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow seven (7) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct; and two (2) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 79A - Eleven (11) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow eight (8) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: two (2) voters were not registered; and one (1) voter voted in the wrong precinct.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 2:28 o'clock p.m. for a brief break.

The Board of Canvassers reconvened at 2:49 o'clock p.m. to continue to review the Challenged Ballots for allowing or disallowing as permitted by law.

County Clerk Thelma J. Gibson informed the Board of Canvassers that the comparison of poll tickets of each precinct to the Statement of Ballots Used as well as the Summary Report generated by the Optical Scanner displaying numbers of ballots cast was completed; and that according to the Ballot Counting Forms, there were thirty-eight (38) ballots over on various precincts; and thirty-eight (38) ballots under on various precincts; that the reason for this discrepancy is that the Absentee Ballots, which were issued by the Circuit Clerk's Office, were sent to the wrong precinct; that the Optical Scanner placed said Absentee Ballots in the proper precinct; and therefore, the Precinct Status Report is in balance.

Precinct No. 79B - Nine (9) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow five (5) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 80 - Fourteen (14) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow four (4) ballots and disallow ten (10) ballots for the following reasons: nine (9) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 82 - Three (3) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow one (1) ballot because the voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 83 - Seventeen (17) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow twelve (12) ballots and disallow five (5) ballots for the following reasons: four (4) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and one (1) voter was not registered.

Precinct No. 84 - Six (6) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow one (1) ballot and disallow five (5) ballots for the following reasons: two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct; and three (3) voters were not registered.

Precinct No. 85 - Five (5) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow three (3) ballots for the following reasons: one (1) voter was not registered; and two (2) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct 86 - Seventeen (17) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow seven (7) ballots and disallow ten (10) ballots for the following reasons: three (3) voters were not registered; and seven (7) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct 87 - Twenty-Eight (28) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow thirteen (13) ballots and disallow fifteen (15) ballots for the following reasons: four (4) voters were not registered; and eleven (11) voters voted in the wrong precinct.

Precinct 88 - Eleven (11) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow nine (9) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters were not registered.

Precinct 91 - Four (4) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Merow, seconded by Commissioner Pyles, and unanimously carried, to allow two (2) ballots and disallow two (2) ballots because the voters were not registered.

The summary of reasons for the two hundred forty-two (242) challenged ballots that were not allowed follows: one hundred thirteen (113) voters voted in the wrong precinct; one hundred twenty-six voters were not registered; and three (3) voters voted absentee and also voted in person.

Thereafter, the Canvassing Board proceeded to remove the Challenged Ballots from their respective envelopes, and to separate the ballot stubs from the ballots to prepare them for tabulation.

An Official Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot from Precinct 91, which was included in the sixty-five (65) Absentee Ballots received from the Circuit Clerk's Office was remade by the Canvassing Board as prescribed by West Virginia State Code.

At 3:40 o'clock p.m., Security Officer Ron Kelly transported the allowed Absentee Ballots and the allowed Challenged Ballots to Room No. 123 of the Monongalia County Courthouse for tabulation by the Optical Scanner. At 3:42 o'clock p.m., the Optical Scanner printed a zero tally and tabulation of said ballots began.

During the tabulation process, one (1) ballot from Precinct 68 was damaged by the Optical Scanner. Said ballot was remade by the Canvassing Board as prescribed by West Virginia State Code.

The tabulation of said ballots was completed at 4:45 o'clock p.m. The County Commissioners signed off on the Zero Report and the generated summary of the allowed Absentee Ballots and the allowed Challenged Ballots.
